

• Varicose Veins: Swollen, twisted veins that often appear blue or dark purple, typically in the

legs. They occur when the valves in the veins fail to function properly, leading to blood pooling and increased pressure. 

A test that uses sound waves to assess the abdominal aorta for aneurysms or other abnormalities.


A diagnostic tool used to assess venous insufficiency in the lower limbs. Ankle Brachial Pressure Index (ABPI)


